Birth Certificate Assistance: Assistance granted for individuals needing LA State ID or for housing Program. (*Homeless letter and Referral Letter needed for both purposes*)

ID assistance: First time IDs require a birth certificate and two other forms of ID

Mail: REGISTRATION REQUIRED.

Mail distribution Tues, Wed, Fri 8:30am-9:00am & 12:30-1:00pm/ (*Need an ID and to pick up mail at least once every 4 weeks*). NO UPS OR FEDEX, see HTC.

Food Stamps & Medicaid Application Assistance: By appointment only. Sign up during meal times.

Prescription Assistance: Referrals given, (*prescription and homeless letter needed*)

Employment Assistance: By appointment only

Emergency Financial Assistance: Individuals must have ID, proof of income, and disconnect notice or letter from Landlord/Realty Company
